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## Narrative

Incident Report

1. Applicable crime and code section:

Lewd Conduct w/ a Minor Child // IC 18-1508

2. Report narrative:

On 08/04/15, I Det. Uhrig received an email from my supervisor, Sgt. D. Beck. The email included a case file Det. B. Armstrong with the Spokane County Sheriff's Office. Sgt. Beck instructed me to investigate the allegations in the case file that are reported to have occurred in Post Falls.

In reviewing the Spokane County case file (case #15-0012851), victim [REDACTED] (18 YOM) has alleged that Kevin G. Sloniker (DOB [REDACTED]) had molested a number of years ago in numerous different jurisdictions over the past decade. Refer to the Spokane County case file for further details.

Kevin and [REDACTED] were family friends and they attended the same church, Immaculate Conception Church in Post Falls. According to the case file, [REDACTED] disclosed one incident of abuse that occurred at [REDACTED] in Post falls, which was [REDACTED] residence. The disclosure was documented as follows:

41. He described the next incident occurring in his own bedroom on the second floor.
42. No one else was present.
43. He said it was daytime, possibly after school hours in the afternoon.
44. He said Kevin came over to his family's house.
45. He said Kevin drove himself.
46. He believed that at home at the time was his mother, brother [REDACTED] and possibly brother [REDACTED].
47. He said that when the two were upstairs in his bedroom that Kevin brought up the topic and was acting "somewhat like a doctor", as he was "checking" on [REDACTED] penis.
48. [REDACTED] remembers his pants being pulled down.
49. He did not recall if Kevin told him to pull his pants down or if Kevin did it himself.
50. [REDACTED] remembers being very embarrassed when he pants were down, so he told Kevin to close the door, which Kevin did.
51. Kevin began rubbing [REDACTED] penis approximately a minute or two.

According to the case file, [REDACTED] was asked if he or Kevin had an erection at the time and he said he did not know. He was asked if he was made to touch Kevin's penis and he said no. [REDACTED] was asked about the frequency of Kevin coming by the family home. He reported that he would typically come by once or twice a month, and it was mainly in a group setting with [REDACTED] family around. [REDACTED] said that from what he recalled, he believed that the frequency of Kevin coming around was higher after the first sexual incident.

According to the case file, [REDACTED] was living in Post Falls between October 2005 and October 2006, meaning that the abuse occurred sometime during that timeframe.

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According to the case file, Sloniker has retained an attorney.

I have since learned that on 09/12/15, the CDA PD began an investigation into Sloniker for molestation on another victim under 15C29666. They subsequently secured an arrest warrant for Sloniker and he was arrested in the mid-west. I have also learned that the CDA PD has uncovered that Sloniker has victimized a number of other juveniles and they are actively investigating.

I have submitted a complaint request against Sloniker for Lewd Conduct with a Minor Child under 16 YOA // 18 18-1508. Nothing further at this time, CAA.

I received information from the CDA PD that their detectives interviewed Sloniker at the KC PSB and he made admissions to his crimes. I have been provided with a copy of the transcript from that interview. I have reviewed the transcript and it shows that Sloniker made admissions regarding molestation conduct involving numerous juveniles. Regarding the victim in this case, ██████████ Sloniker admitted to touching him, but was vague about the context. he admitted that the ██████████ family was the first family he ever hung out with and he wished he never knew them. He also admitted to showing ██████████ how to masturbate.

With all of Sloniker's admissions from the interview, it is clear that he has victimized a number of boys and shows a pattern and practice of doing so.
