Why Donate To a 501(c)3 Before New Years?

Some donors give to 501(c)3 charities like LifeSiteNews not just because they value our mission, but also because such gifts are tax-deductible contributions that can reduce donors' liability to the IRS.

That's why we receive many donations right up until New Year's Eve as people make strategic gifts benefiting our mission and their tax-savings.

Why Are Gifts of Stocks So Beneficial?

If your stocks have appreciated in value since you bought them, then you will face a capital gains tax bill should you sell.

Some people instead donate stocks to a 501(c)3 to avoid paying any capital gains tax. Those stocks can then be sold by the charity without any capital gains tax liability for either party.

Is Donating Appreciated Stocks As Easy As It seems?

Yes, all the details you or your broker will need for LifeSiteNews are printed below. Please allow up to 3 days for the transfer to take place.

How Can I Donate To LifeSite From My IRA And Lower My Tax Bill?

IRA account holders must take taxable Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) from age 73 and onward, whether the income is needed or not.

To avoid or reduce that income tax, some people choose to make non-taxable Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs) as part of their RMD obligations.

After an IRA account holder turns 70½, they can give up to \$105,000 in 2025 (and \$108,000 in 2026, indexed for inflation) annually from their IRA directly to one or multiple charities, using a QCD form issued by their IRA administrator.
